<i>Absidia corymbifera</i>	2	Ear swab (1)	DE+. Clinically fungal otitis externa.
		Shin wound (1)	Multi trauma RTA, fracture femur.
<i>Aspergillus fumigatus</i>	5	BW (4)	T-cell ALL. Neutropenic. Chest lesion. On prophylactic FCZ → LAmB (1), newly diagnosed AML, HRCT showed severe bilateral upper lobe nodules with surrounding ground glass appearance. Rx VOR with clinical improvement (1), post lung transplant (1), oncology patient. Culture negative. BW Galactomannan = 6.8 +ve (1).
		Sphenoid (1)	Pituitary adenoma, intra-op noted to have sphenoid sinus mycetoma → surgically removed.
<i>Aspergillus terreus</i>	1	Eye socket	Post bomb blast traumatic injury.
<i>Dissitimurus exedrus</i>	1	Maxillary antrum contents	DE+. Allergic sinusitis not resolved with surgery.
<i>Fusarium</i> species	1	Scalp skin scraping	DE+ with fungal elements characteristic of a mould seen. Recurrent staphylococcal infections. Hyper-IgE syndrome.
<i>Paecilomyces lilacinus</i>	1	Exit site swab	DE-ve. Haemodialysis patient, colonisation at exit site.
<i>Phialophora richardsiae</i>	1	Fluid from hallux	DE-ve. Fluctuant mass.

<i>Aureobasidium pullans</i>	1	Foot dorsum lump & ankle joint	DE-ve. Isolated from the two areas 1 month apart.
<i>Candida albicans</i>	31	Blood culture (23)	UTI, abdominal complications. ICU patient. Rx FCZ (1), influenza patient on ECMO (1), ulcerative colitis with total colectomy and J-pouch formation. Rx FCZ (1), oesophageal SCC with broncho-oesophageal fistula. Rx FCZ (1), HSV skin infection, line sepsis (1), CF (1), severe congenital diaphragmatic hernia, jejunostomy and gastrostomy tubes <i>in-situ</i> . On TPN (1), enterocutaneous fistula (1), line sepsis (2), spinal unit patient (1), ICU patient (2), post surgery (1), patient deceased, necrotising pancreatitis (1), caecal perforation 2° to surgery (1), multi organ failure, ulcerative colitis, deceased (1), COPD, urosepsis, liver failure, deceased (1), fistula (1), acute disseminated encephomyelitis (1), perforated duodenal ulcer, septic post-op (1), NR(2).
		Pleural aspirate (2)	Post laparotomy for strangulated hernia, empyema (1), NR (1).

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		Skin biopsy – multiple sites (1)	Meningococcal septicaemia. Patient deceased.
		Gallbladder aspirate (1)	Post cholecystectomy.
		Peritoneal aspirate (1)	Perforated duodenal ulcer, recurrent bowel obstructions.
		CAPD (2)	Diabetes, ESRF with peritonitis (1), NR (1).
		Wound swab (1)	Sternal wound infection post lung transplant. Rx FCZ.
<i>Candida albicans &amp; C. glabrata</i>	1	Gallbladder aspirate	Post cholecystectomy.
<i>Candida albicans &amp; C. parapsilosis complex</i>	2	Blood	Elderly surgical patient (1), 80% burns following petrol explosion (1).
<i>Candida dubliniensis</i>	2	Liver biopsy (1)	DE+. ALL patient already on antifungal agents & failed to grow. Sample sent for 18S DNA sequencing.
		Pus from breast collection (1)	Haematoma in implant cavity.
<i>Candida glabrata</i>	9	Blood (8)	AML (1), line sepsis (1), congenital cerebral palsy, patient deceased (1), severe spina bifida, VP shunt <i>in-situ</i> (1), patient deceased, NR (1), multiple isolations, presumptive endocarditis following AVR. Rx AmB & CAS (1), gastric lymphoma. Rx AmB → FCZ (1), patient deceased 2° to thigh myositis; also isolated with MRSA (1).
		Pleural aspirate (1)	Spina bifida, post laparotomy.
<i>Candida guilliermondii</i>	1	Blood	CGD X-linked with severe phenotype, line sepsis.
<i>Candida kefyr, C. krusei &amp; C. lusitaniae</i>	1	Bile	Liver transplant 2006 due to Hepatitis B. Now graft failure.
<i>Candida lusitaniae</i>	1	Blood	Oncology patient.
<i>Candida parapsilosis complex</i>	27	Blood (11)	CF, line sepsis, portacath placed for antibiotic delivery (1), ICU patient post surgical repair of chronic enterocutaneous fistulation (1), AML (1), adenocarcinoma, multi-organ failure. Deceased (1), post abdominal surgery. Rx FCZ (1), lupus nephritis → renal transplant. Line sepsis (1), osteomyelitis. Rx FCZ (1), TB osteomyelitis on spine & finger. Rx FCZ (1), haemodialysis (1), NR (2).
		Thumb bone (1)	Diabetes, osteomyelitis of distal phalanx.
		Knee aspirate (2)	IHD, kidney disease, gout, Rx FCZ with marked improvement (1), RA, steroid use. Not treated (1).
		CAPD (12)	ESRF on CAPD.
		Ankle aspirate (1)	Osteomyelitis. Rx FCZ → cured.
<i>Candida tropicalis</i>	4	Blood (3)	Respiratory patient (1), cholecystectomy, pancreatectomy for tumour, splenectomy. Patient died (1), diverticulitis & fistula, recurrent

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			bowel obstructions (1).
		CAPD (1)	Type I diabetes, ESRF on CAPD. Rx FCZ.
<i>Cryptococcus neoformans</i>	2	CSF (1)	ALL.
		Blood (1)	NR.
<i>Malassezia pachydermatis</i>	1	Blood	Preterm baby.
<i>Rhodotorula</i> spp	1	Blood	Fever.
 <i>Pneumocystis jiroveci (carinii)</i>	18	BW/BAL (7)	Breast Ca, immunocompromised, ground glass appearance on CXR (1), immunocompromised with ground glass appearance on CXR (1), myeloma (1), myelofibrosis (1), T-cell lymphoma (1), NR (2)
		Sputum/Induced sputum (10)	HIV+ (5), lymphoma (1), Oncology patient (2), multiple myeloma, post stem cell transplant (1), NR (1).
		Lung tissue (1)	Post mortem sample. HIV+.

<i>Gordonia bronchialis</i>	1	Abdominal wall	3/52 history of sudden appearance of lump below umbilicus, consistent with haematoma of abdominal wall.
<i>Nocardia abscessus</i>	1	Corneal scrape	Mechanic something fall in eye whilst working under motor vehicle.
<i>Nocardia asteroides</i> complex	3	Sputum (1)	NR.
		Wound swab (1)	Injured hand whilst gardening → ulcerating hand wound.
		Bronchial washing (1)	Bronchiectasis.
<i>Nocardia farcinica</i>	2	Pleural fluid (1)	DE+, elderly.
		BW (1)	LUL mass. DE+.
<i>Nocardia nova</i> complex	2	Sputum	Bronchiectasis.
<i>Nocardia nova</i>	5	BW (1)	Pulmonary infiltrate.
		Sputum (3)	3 different patients, repeatedly isolated from TB enrichment culture, ?significance.
		Thigh & axilla (1)	Multiple co-morbidities including renal transplant & diabetes. Widespread <i>Nocardia</i> abscesses including brain. Patient died.
<i>N. nova</i> & <i>Gordonia</i> spp	1	Eye socket	Enucleated eye.
<i>Nocardia veterena</i>	1	Sputum	Non-resolving chest infection, been on Ciprofloxacin.
<i>Rhodococcus</i> species	2	Tibial nail (1)	Fracture tibia with fixators <i>in-situ</i> .
		Spine (1)	Deep distal spine wound.
<i>Tsukumurella</i> spp	3	Sputum	3 different patients, repeatedly isolated from TB enrichment culture, ?significance.
