<b>Filamentous fungi</b>			
<i>Alternaria alternate</i>	1	Maxillary sinus tissue	Oncology patient.
<i>Aspergillus fumigatus</i>	2	Sputum (1)	DE +. Hodgkin's lymphoma. Rx VOR.
		CAPD fluid (1)	DE +. ESRF on CAPD.
<i>Aspergillus fumigatus</i> & <i>A. niger</i>	1	Bronchial Washing	Severe asthma, long term steroid use. Necrotising <i>Aspergillus</i> lung infection. Rx VOR + lobectomy. Improved.
<i>Fusarium oxysporum</i>	1	Leg Wound	DE +. Diabetic with leg cellulitis. Prior fall ~ 3weeks earlier to admission, foreign body in leg. Extensive surgical debridement.
<i>Phoma cruris-hominis</i>	1	Toe aspirate	Recurrent swelling in base of toe.
<b>Yeasts</b>			
<i>Candida albicans</i>	7	Blood culture	Infant with severe meningococcal septicaemia. Extensive pupura fulminans, limb & facial ischaemia, extensive loss of nasal & lip tissue. Lines <i>in-situ</i> . Patient deceased (1), premature baby, on broad spectrum antibiotics. Line <i>in-situ</i> (1), excision of uteric anastomosis onto neobladder, line sepsis. Rx FCZ (1), post-op laparotomy. Rx FCZ (1), high voltage electrical burns 50% (1) ICU patient, line <i>in-situ</i> (1), ALL, neutropenic (1).
<i>Candida glabrata</i> complex	3	Blood	Uteric stone (1), terminal lung malignancy, sepsis & bowel obstruction. Patient deceased (1), colon Ca (1).
<i>Candida guilliermondii</i>	3	Blood (1)	Line sepsis.
		CAPD fluid (2)	ESRF on CAPD.
<i>Candida parapsilosis</i> complex	8	Blood (6)	Oncology patient. Line sepsis (1), infant with short gut syndrome, line sepsis. Rx FCZ & line removal (1), Crohn's disease, colectomy with stoma (1), CF patient, line sepsis (1), chronic bowel obstruction (1), dialysis patient (1).
		CAPD (2)	Diabetic with ESRF (2)
<i>Candida tropicalis</i>	2	Blood (1)	Hemi-colectomy for bowel obstruction. Protracted recovery in ICU. Rx FCZ. Patient deceased.
		Urine (1)	Burkitt's lymphoma. Admitted to hospital with back pain & renal impairment. Found 6mm kidney stone. JJ stent inserted. Rx FCZ.

<i>Cryptococcus gattii</i>	1	Lung FNA	Patient from Cook Islands. 3-4 months breathlessness.
<i>Cryptococcus neoformans</i>	4	CSF (1)	2° to immunosuppression from chronic steroid use. Rx AmB + 5FC. Good clinical response.
		Bronchial washing (1)	Cavitating RUL pulmonary lesion. Diabetic patient with ESRF.
		Lung FNA (2)	DE +ve. Post cardiac transplant (1), past alcohol use. Chronic Hepatitis C, awaiting liver transplant. Rx FCZ (1).
<b><i>Pneumocystis jiroveci (carinii)</i></b>			
	5	BW/BAL (2)	On dexamethasone, diffuse patchy ground glass infiltrates seen in CXR (1), NR (1).
		Sputum/Induced sputum (3)	Lymphoma (1), on methotrexate (1), NR (1).

<i>Nocardia asteroides</i> complex	1	Sputum	DE+. NR.
